College/Tech School News:

We have received news that TCAT will be sending out emails to all applicants in the near future. If students do not response to this email within TEN days, students will lose their place in the application process. We encourage students to check their emails (the email that you used when completing the TCAT online application) at least weekly. Also, applicants should get all paperwork returned to TCAT, no later than May 24, 2019, to ensure Fall enrollment.

Carson Newman University:

A CN representative will be here on 3/25/19 during both lunches to talk to interested students. Seniors who are Hope eligible, have an EFC of 0, and completed the FAFSA by 1/30/2019 may be eligible for tuition scholarship.

WSCC:

Important!-Students should check their WSCC Senators email to receive instructions on signing up for Freshmen Orientation. Students cannot register for classes if Freshmen Orientation not completed. Don't wait until last minute to complete orientation-you may not get the class schedule that you want!
