<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Dual Enrollment (DE)</b></p> <p>Three DE courses which meet designated requirements through an approved post-secondary institution. To receive college credit, student must pass the course. Eligibility criteria do apply. Student must pass course to receive college credit. DE grant is available to assist with funding. All AP courses will be offered online, except possibly for AP Biology, depending upon demand. A passing score on the AP Exam could potentially mean college credit, depending on the college's score requirement (Each college has their own individual AP score requirement to qualify for college credit).</p>
