

1. NJROTC Continuing Instructional Plan

To date 45 Cadets have enrolled in the **JROTC College Prep** website and are working the questions and subjects. GOOD on YOU!, who have done so. Keep up the great work.

Now the remainder of our Corps of Cadets are required to log on, create a logon and start the process. Remember, this is a **Required and Gradable Assignment** of which you will receive a grade upon returning to school.

Log on to our Cocke County NJROTC website: www.cockecountynjrotc.com. Click on the KNOWLEDGE Tab at the top of the screen. The drop down tab “JROTC College Prep” will take you to the ACT Prep Program. If you have not done so, Register for a new account. If you have an account, continue to study for a minimum 30 minutes a day – 10 to 15 questions. LtCol Ivory will monitor, keep track of who is and who isn't.

2. NJROTC Standards of Performance (SOP) Assignment.

- a. Section 1 – The NJROTC Program & Curriculum, find the paragraph **Learning Organization**, where you will find the “NJROTC Learning Organization five-step process of training.
Assignment: Explain in great detail how we complete the process in our daily teaching. A detailed 2-4 paragraphs for each step is needed to adequately explain each step. We're looking for answers that state: what it is, what it means, how we go about completing the steps, and how it pertains to personal and organizational leadership. Verbiage shown in the section should not be part of your answer.
- b. Write a detailed explanation of the NJROTC grading of Aptitude. Copying directly from the SOP is not a correct answer. Write it in your own words, no less than two paragraphs of 5-8 sentences each.
- c. **Platoon Commander is one of the most important jobs in NJROTC.**
Assignment: Write the responsibilities of being a Platoon Commander. Include those that may not be listed in the SOP.
