### **New Scholarships Now Available In Counseling Office:**

- Alpha Delta Kappa Sorority \$500 Scholarship now available in Counseling Dept. Must plan on pursuing an Education Field Major. Deadline to turn in to Counseling Dept is 3/30/2020.
- Cocke County Business Women Scholarships now available- one scholarship is for technical/vocational school and one is for college. Deadline to submit application to Counseling Dept is 3/30/2020.
- \$1000 Farm Bureau Scholarship- open to seniors going into Ag-related field (food, nutrition, Ag. Teacher, farm-related, veterinarian, etc). Min 3.0 GPA OR Min ACT Composite of 21. Deadline to submit is 3/24/2020
- Cocke County Education Foundation Scholarship-More than 15 scholarships on one application. Deadline to submit to Counseling Dept is 3/24/2020, no later than 3:30 pm.
- GSMR J.Pritchard Barnes Scholarship-Must submit essay up to 400 word limit on role models, goals, philosophy of life, and anyone or anything that has made a difference in your life and what this scholarship means to you. Deadline to submit to CHS Counseling Dept.is 3/26/2020, by 3:00 pm
- Lowland Credit Union Lee Johns Memorial Scholarship-Seniors must have a min 3.0 GPA and be a member of Lowland Credit Union (parents membership does not apply). Must complete an essay. Apply at <https://lowlandcu.org/2020-scholarship-application/>. Deadline to submit online is no later than 5 pm, 3/27/2020.
- Horatio Alger National Career & Technical Scholarship Program now open for seniors pursuing a 2 year or less career or technical degree/certificate program in fall that will lead to employment. Must demonstrate financial need; be Pell Grant eligible. Apply at [application.horatioalger.org](http://application.horatioalger.org). Deadline to submit is 4/15/2020.
- Kiwanis Key Club Scholarship application is now available in the Counseling Dept. Deadline to submit is 3/24/2020. Requirements include: Registered member of Key Club at least two out of four years, Min 3.0 weighted GPA, Minimum of 20 Key Club community service hours.
- Commercial Bank "Spirit" \$500 Scholarship. Requirements include Min. 3.0 GPA. Application available in the Counseling Dept. with a deadline of 3/24/2020.

## March Checklist:

- ✓ Upon acceptance from any college/tech school, please follow instructions to set-up your electronic college/tech accounts (email, student account, ect). Most schools will give you information such as how to register for orientation, class registration, and financial aid info through their email system.
- ✓ If you have applied to a post-secondary institution and have not received an acceptance letter, usually within 2 to 3 weeks, please inquire with the admission's office for confirmation.
- ✓ Check with your college/tech school of choice to make sure all financial aid paperwork is completed, especially, if selected for verification.
- ✓ Submit transcripts for any college/tech school applications submitted.
- ✓ Be prepared to apply for scholarships. Complete a resume and obtain recommendation letters.

#### Criteria:

First-time, full-time freshmen eligible for the Tennessee Education Lottery (HOPE) Scholarship and the maximum Pell Grant. Promise Plus provides last-dollar assistance covering tuition and program service fees, PLUS more.

ETSU Promise Plus provides students the support they need to be successful and reach their dream of earning a college degree by providing:

- Up to \$6,000 on-campus housing scholarship (\$1,500 annually)
- FREE participation in pre-college programs including new student orientation, Preview ETSU (extended orientation), and early move-in
